There are many points of curiosity and wonder in our town and daily lifestyles that we often do not notice. Curiosity is the door into the world of science.







Planetarium

The hybrid planetarium with a dome diameter of 30 meters is a fusion between an optical projector and an all-sky digital projector.



This area is for small children who may cry or make noise during the presentation, or who may be frightened of the dark. Visitors seated here can enjoy the presentation without having to worry about keeping their children quiet.
